SUBJECT: Valerie Lane Water Line Replacement  
Paducah Water General Permit No. 2011-12

This project meets the qualifications and requirements to be approved under the General Permit authorized by Agreed Order No. DWO-06004. Paducah Water has reviewed and approved the proposed water distribution plans for the above referenced improvements project. These plans will not have to be submitted to the KY DOW per the Agreed Order. If you have any questions or we can be of further assistance, please call Darran Rankin at 270.444.5581.

The following information identifies the responsibilities of Paducah Water and the Contractor:

a. Paducah Water Responsibility

- Paducah Water will provide C900 SDR 14 PVC pipe for the project.
- Paducah Water will provide 2 fire hydrant assemblies (fire hydrants, valves, connection pieces & anchoring tees).
- Paducah Water will provide a 6" tapping sleeve, valve and make the tap.
- Paducah Water will relocate the existing water meter settings and connect to the existing service lines upon completion and activation of the new six (6) inch water main

b. Deposit & Tap Fee

- This project will not require a deposit.
- Paducah Water has waived the Tap Fee of one thousand five hundred fifty dollars (\$1550.).

c. Contractor Responsibility

- The Contractor will provide all fittings, joint restraints, tracer wire, buried caution tape, cast iron valve boxes and concrete valve pads.
- The Contractor will install, test and disinfect the water main.

The set of Standard Specifications and plans submitted and approved by Paducah Water shall be the guiding documents throughout the construction of the project.

If construction has not been completed within twelve (12) months from the date of approval of the plans and specifications for this project, you will need to resubmit all applications, plans and specifications to Paducah Water for re-approval. If you are required to re-submit your project for approval, the review will be based on PW's Standard Specifications and Regulatory requirements in force at that time. If there are any modifications to this project they should be submitted to PW for review and approval.

Please provide us with two (2) copies of the drawings prior to construction for use during inspection of the construction of this project.

After construction is complete, PW's Engineering Department will require As-Built record drawings to be submitted prior to the final punch list inspection and installation of water meters. Following receipt of the record drawings, a one (1) year warranty period shall be established for the continued responsibility for the ownership and maintenance by the developer. After all punch list items are completed, inspected and approved by PW and the one (1) year warranty period has expired, PW will include this project into its distribution system for ownership and maintenance.
